# SPECIAL R1000 AWARD

In order to promote the versatile nature of the Welsh breeds, a special Awards have been sponsored amounting to R1000 each for the following:-

The winner of the Supreme Champion in the In-Hand Breed Class where more than 10 ponies are competing in that class for any Section will receive this Award provided it has competed in the Driving and/or Riding classes for that Section, and

The winner of the Supreme Champion Harness and Driving Champion will receive this Award provided it has also competed in the In-Hand Breed Class for that Section comprising more than 10 ponies.

# WELSH PONIES AND COBS, SOUTH AFRICA, JOURNAL

We are pleased to announce that arrangements have been made with the Publisher/Editor of the Journal, Welsh Ponies and Cobs, South Africa, to distribute the Journal free of charge to our members with effect from 2016. It is understood that members of only those Societies which have made such arrangements will receive the Journal distributed to them free of charge towards the end of the year.

## PASSPORTS – ARE YOURS VALID?

There appears to be confusion about which passports are still valid. As shown below in a WhatsApp between Mymona Salie Samuels (MSS) and Dr Camilla Weyers (CW) of the Veterinary Unit of the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, the old green passport which was issued by the WPCS of South Africa is no longer valid or acceptable and ponies with these passports will NOT be allowed to enter the AHS Protocol Area of the Western Cape. Veterinary Surgeons have been reminded not to endorse passports which are not valid nor to issue Movement Certificates for such ponies. Here is the time-line of this exchange:

"2016/05/20, 21:46 – MSS: Sorry to bother just want to know if this passports (WPCS South Africa) r still valid as people r a bit confuse we have new ones but doc said we can still use the old ones

2016/05/20, 23:33 – CW: Nope. Those ones are not valid. The new ones that the Welsh Society (WPCS, Africa) have just started issuing will be accepted. But not those old ones (WPCS, South Africa). Only the fei ones, The import export ones and new studbook ones and now the new Welsh ones (WPCS, Africa)

2016/05/21, 00:07-MSS: Thz please let dr Neuland know cos people say he said the old Welsh ones still valid

2016/05/21, 06:46 – CW: Ok. I'll email him again. He has been emailed lots of times though and told by Gary Buhrmann"

The message is clear, either get a passport for your ponies which has been approved by Veterinary Services of DAFF or your ponies will NOT be allowed back into the AHS Protocol Area.
